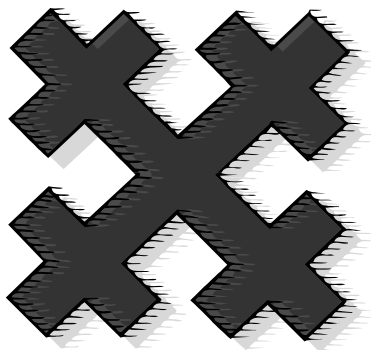

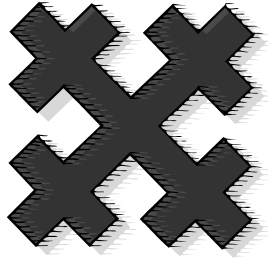

Law** is the founder and Executive Director of the Kaleidoscope Institute for Competent Leadership in a Diverse, Changing World (website: [www.ladiocese.org/ki](http://www.ladiocese.org/ki)). He is the author of five books in the field of multicultural ministry and building inclusive community. His last book, *The Word at the Crossings* (2004), focuses on the ministry of preaching in multi-contextual communities. His first book, *The Wolf Shall Dwell with the Lamb* (1993), continues to be a best-seller and is a required text for most seminary educations. It is now available in Spanish.

Eric has been guest preacher, lecturer, and consultant for seminaries and for all the major Christian denominations in the United States, Canada, Australia, and Europe. He is an Episcopal priest, composer of church music, photographer, and playwright.

Stacy's extensive educational, cross cultural, and anti-racism experience began with her growing up in south central Los Angeles, CA. Her writings include contributions to *Weaving God's Love Across Cultures*, *Sacred Sea*, *Lutheran Woman Today*, *Women of the ELCA* cross cultural materials, and youth ministry resources. Stacy's education includes degrees from UCLA and McCormick Theological Seminary.
